As part of the “critical infrastructure”, **the township offices will not be open to the public.** The Township Treasurer and Clerk will be maintaining critical work, but this may not mean there are regular hours. You can also contact the township through our township website www.boisblanctownship.org. Should you need something that you must have physical access to the township for, (like trash bags), please call and make an appointment to pick-up your bags. They will be marked and left outside. Payment in the form of a check can be put in the drop box.

We would also like to stress the following:

“To suppress the spread of COVID-19, to prevent the state’s health care system from being overwhelmed, to allow time for the production of critical test kits, ventilators, and personal protective equipment, and to avoid needless deaths, **it is reasonable and necessary to direct residents to remain at home or in their place of residence to the maximum extent feasible.**”

Based on the Governor’s Executive order 2020-21 “Stay Home, Stay Safe”, and the Presidents extension of social distancing rules to April 30, 2020, the township board would like to remind island residents, property owners and visitors of the following:

- All non-residents travel to the island should be delayed until after we get through the pandemic.
- Flights to the island should be limited to medical transportation, Emergency personnel and freight only.
- There are no public resources open and operating on the island. (Restaurants/Bars/Camping/Gas etc)
- About 50% of our current island population is “at risk” due to age or compromised health.
- We do not have medical facilities and the capability to handle an emergency here, so evacuation to a surrounding hospital would be necessary.
- There is limited access to emergency care in the greater area.
