- The results of the DNR visit were discussed to the committee.
  - Highlights are: Land Use Permit for placement of trash cans and picnic tables currently applied for has been granted. Need proof of Liability Insurance Coverage from the Township Board.
  - New Land Use Permit should be applied for the new locations for Disbursed Camping at Lake Thompson, Twin Lakes and both North Shore locations.
  - 3. Toilet Vaults are not recommended at this time. Handicapped portable toilets are recommended until actual site usage can be determined. Diane will call a local provider in Cheboygan and get quotes.
  - 4. Determining site usage for Lake Thompson and North Shore can be done by the use of game cameras.
  - 5. Removal of trash at North Shore and Twin lakes should take place immediately before the upcoming Memorial Day Weekend.
