  of Michigan will be conducted here on Bois Blanc Island on September 29,
  2018 at 10:00AM. Victor Babcock will escort anyone interested to, what he
  knows to be, the largest White Pine on the island.
- 5 Year Plan in progress. Missing overview, description and administrative structure. Will spend entire meeting (Oct. 13) to finish.
- Future fund raisers were discussed.
  - Received \$243 from donations for this year's activities.
  - Michigan Nature Conservancy has donated a canoe. Disposition ideas included a raffle; grand prize for events such as 5K walk or fishing tournament. No disposition reached.
  - Stars from flag burning are still available for use. Suggestions were to mount them in a frame or on a weathered board then lacquered to be sold. Questions arose as to the legality of such a sale. Tom will investigate.
  - 5K Run/Walk for 2019 to be held 4<sup>th</sup> of July week end. Location suggestions were Bible Farm start. Details such as routes; volunteers; permission; liabilities; advertisements; sponsorships; prizes; entry fees are still to be worked out.
  - Two previous BBI Cook Books were brought in for review. Suggestions
    were made to duplicate them and re-print the originals for sale for
    nostalgic reasons or to create a new book with recipes donated from the
    current residents.

- Just Kids activities to coincide with the East/West Ball game fund raiser were discussed. Suggestions include a Whiffle Ball game and bike decorating competition and parade.
