

2. An ordinance relative to damaged buildings or structures or part thereof within the village limits of the township of Bois Blanc.

Section 1.

It shall be the duty of the owner, lessee, occupant or other party responsible for all buildings, structures or parts thereof, situated within the limits of Bois Blanc Township, that have heretofore, or that may hereafter, become damaged by fire, lightning, windstorm or other calamity or shall become depreciated by neglect, misuse, or nonuse, to such an extent as to render the same uninhabitable or not fit for use for which it was intended, to within sixty days after the occurrence of such damage or depreciation, to repair or reconstruct the same and render the same habitable and fit for use; or to remove the remains of said building or structure or part thereof, within the said period of sixty days, provided that an extension of time therefore may be granted by the township board of Bois Blanc Island for good reason.

Section 2.

It shall be the duty of the law enforcement officer of the township to supervise the tearing down and removal of any and all buildings, structures or parts thereof which shall have been damaged by fire, lightning, windstorm or other calamity and which shall not have been repaired or removed as required in Section 1 of this ordinance and shall keep an account of such expense of such tearing down and removal and the amount of such expense shall become a debt against the owner, lessee or party responsible and may be recovered by the township board of Bois Blanc Island in an action at law or the amount of such expense may be certified by the township clerk to the assessor of said township and such amount so certified shall be assessed against the property where such expense was incurred in the next general assessment.

Section 3.

Penalties: Any person who is convicted of any violation of and provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine not to exceed one hundred (\$100) or by imprisonment in the county jail not to exceed ninety (90) days or by both fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the trial court upon each count or offense of which such person be convicted.

This ordinance was passed and adopted by the Township board on May 7, 1977 and was published on May 12, 1977 in the Republican News. This ordinance was filed with the Mackinac county clerk and Judge Woods, 92nd District Court, St. Ignace on May 12, 1977. This ordinance shall become effective on June 11, 1977.
