An Ordinance to regulate the parking at the public dock, dock causeway and causeway parking lot; and the establishment of a parking violations bureau.

Section 1. Definitions

- a. The term motor vehicle shall mean that the vehicle as described by the state of Michigan Vehicle Code , Act 300 of Michigan Public Acts of 1949, as amended. (Appendix A)
- b. The dock is described as the Bois Blanc Township Waterways Dock.
- c. The causeway is described as the approach to said Dock and the same shall be so designated by appropriated signs.
- d. The parking lot is described as the public parking place provided and located to the Northeast and Northwest of said causeway and commonly known as the “48 hours lot”.

Section 2 Parking Regulations

- a. There shall be no parking of motor vehicles on the Dock. For the purpose of loading and unloading passengers, luggage and freight from incoming and outgoing watercraft. Standing of a motor vehicle shall be allowed.
- b. Parking on the causeway shall be limited to 30 minutes, a motor vehicle parked beyond the said initial 30 minute period be in violation of this ordinance and the fine for said violation shall be \$5.00 for each 30 minute period or part thereof; and said motor vehicle which is in violation of said parking regulation for more than 2 hours shall be deemed an obstruction to traffic and shall be towed away, in accordance with Section 673 of said P.A. 300 of 1949 (Appendix A).
- c. Parking in the Parking Lot (48 hour lot) shall be limited to 48 hours without charge; thereafter parking of a motor vehicle in said Parking Lot shall be permitted at the rate (fee) of \$1.00 for each 24 hour period or part thereof, up to five such successive 24 hour periods; thereafter the said motor vehicle shall be parked in violation of the parking regulations and a fine of \$5.00 shall be imposed for each 24 hour period said motor vehicle remains in said parking lot in violation for a period longer than 10 days, then said motor vehicle may be towed away under rules and regulations as set forth in section 252A of aid Act 300 as amended (Appendix A).

Section 3 Parking Violations Bureau

- a. In accordance with Michigan Public Act #154 of 1968,(Appendix L) the Township does hereby establish of Parking Violations Bureau to accept civil infractions admissions in parking violations cases and to collect and retain civil fines and costs as prescribed; the Township Clerk shall be the clerk of said Bureau and maintain a separate record of said

parking fines as collected by said Bureau, the Township Board shall be the said Bureau and make all decisions in regard to said Bureau.

b. All parking fees as distinguished from parking fines shall be collected and managed by the Bois Blanc Island Harbor Commission.

Section 4

Governing, Managing and Operation of said parking.

a. The said Dock, Causeway and Parking Lot is under the supervision of Bois Blanc Island harbor Commission by and through authority by an earlier establishment Township Ordinance and this ratifies the authority of these parking regulations, granting to the Harbor Master or Deputy Harbor Master the authority to issue parking violations and collection of said parking fees set forth above.

Section 5 Conflict

a. All ordinances or parts of ordinances now in effect and in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

b. This ordinance supersedes Ordinance No. 5.
