

6. An ordinance relating to the keeping of animals or fowl within the Pines Sub-Division of Bois Blanc Township, or allowing animals or fowl to run at large and setting penalties for violating thereof.

Section 1

That it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to keep or confine or otherwise secure horses, ponies, burros, hogs, cattle, sheep, goats, or any other animal or fowl within the limits of the Pines Sub-division, Bois Blanc Township; nor shall it be lawful to allow such animals or fowl to run at large within the Pines Sub-division of Bois Blanc Township.

Section 2

The lawful use of such land and/or buildings for the above purposes existing at the time of the adoption of this ordinance may be continued, although such use does not conform with the provisions thereof. In the event that a non-conforming use of any building or premises for such purposes is discontinued for a period of one (1) year or that such building or premises is sold, or otherwise changes ownership; the use of same shall thereafter conform to the terms of this ordinance.

Section 3

The provisions of this ordinance shall not be construed or interpreted as applying to the keeping of any cat, dog, canary, parakeet or similar pet or bird normally kept as a pet within any dwelling house or place of business within the said Pines Sub-division, Bois Blanc Township.

Section 4

Dog licenses are available from the Township Treasurer upon presentation of evidence of rabies inoculation for \$1.00 – male or neutered, \$2.00 – female per year.

Section 5

Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance upon conviction thereof be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine not exceeding \$100 or imprisonment in the county jail for a period not to exceed 90 days or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court.

This ordinance was passed and adopted by the Township Board on May 7, 1977 and was published on May 12, 1977 in the Republican

News. This ordinance was filed with the Mackinac county clerk and Judge Woods, 92nd District Court, St. Ignace on May 12, 1977. This ordinance shall become effective on June 11, 1977.
